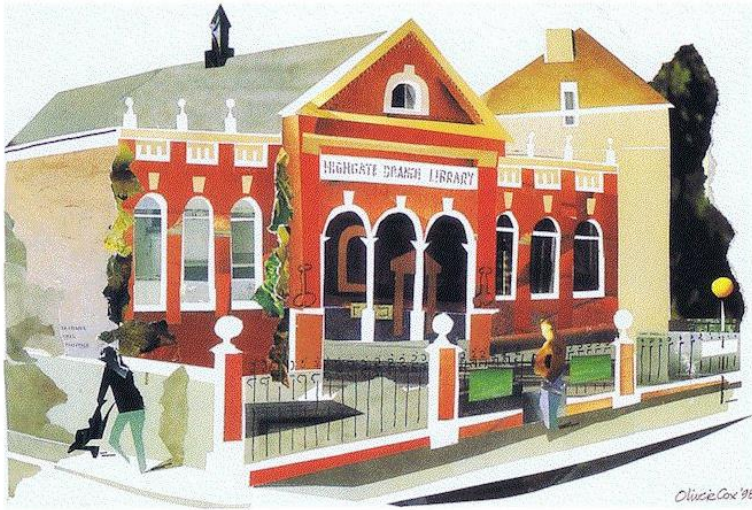

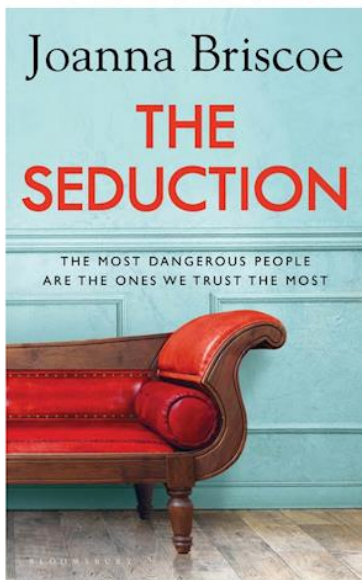

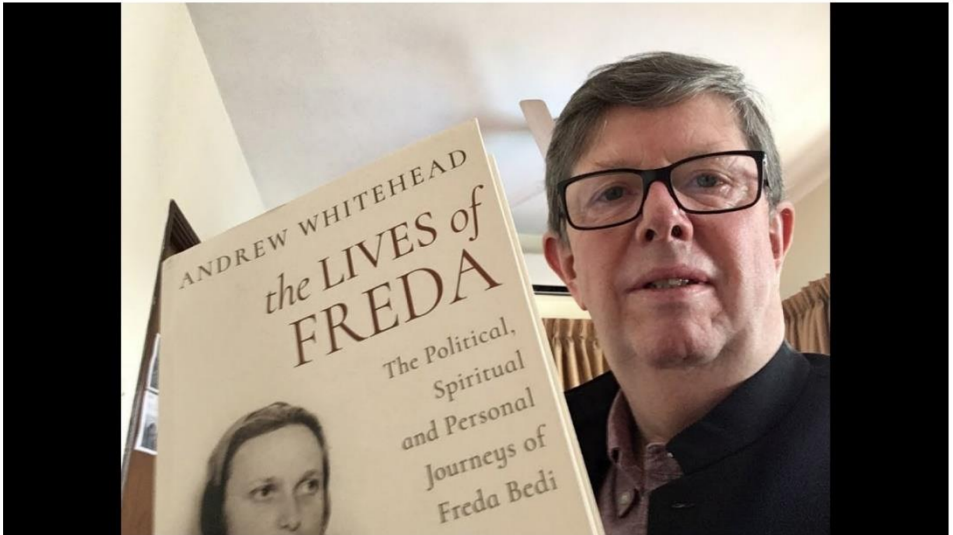

'The Lives of Freda' Andrew Whitehead



Freda Houlston, from the Midlands, fell in love with an Indian fellow student at Oxford University. They married in 1933 and from that moment Freda regarded herself as Indian. They became a noted left-wing, nationalist couple - both were jailed by the British. Freda later became the first western woman to receive full ordination as a Tibetan Buddhist nun.

Andrew Whitehead is a historian and journalist and was a BBC correspondent in Delhi. He has a PhD in the modern history of Kashmir and is an honorary professor at the University of Nottingham and also teaches in Chennai.

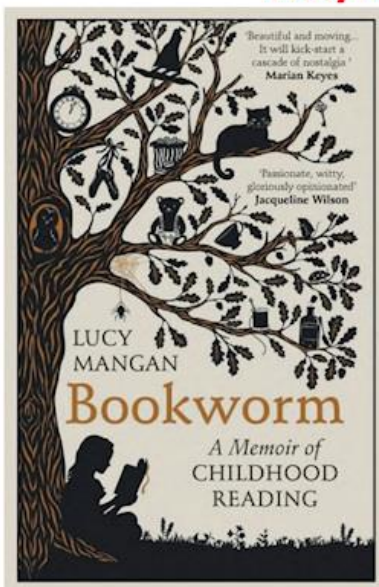
