The pandemic has exposed and amplified underlying inequalities that lead to inequalities in health. Join us to hear from Sir Michael Marmot, Director of the Institute of Health Equity (UCL). Michael has been Professor of Epidemiology at UCL since 1985. He is the Advisor to the WHO Director-General, on social determinants of health and is the recipient of the WHO Global Hero Award.
